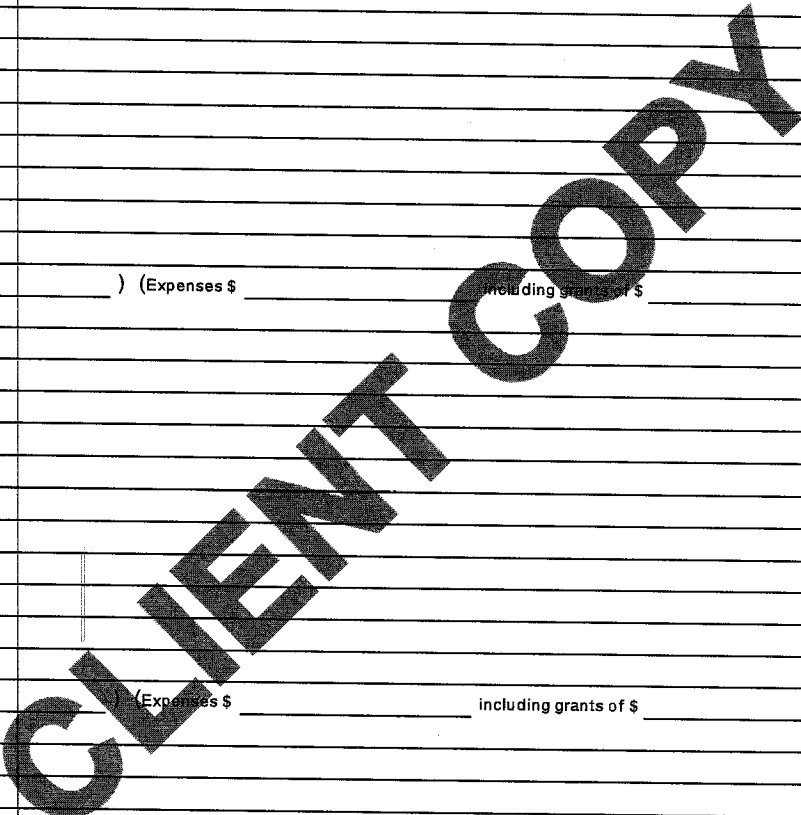

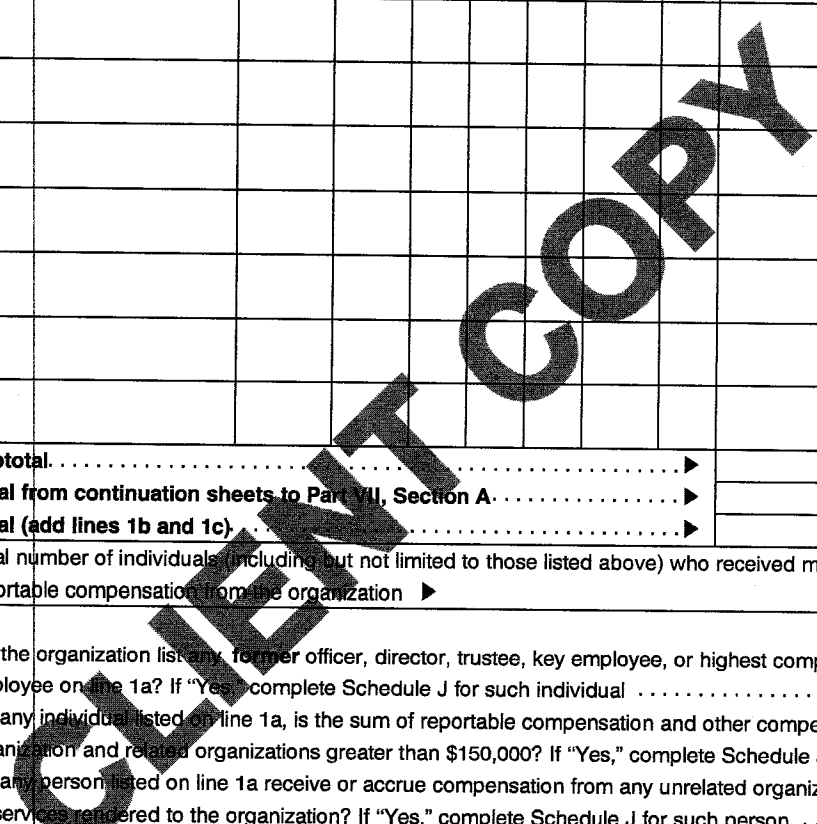

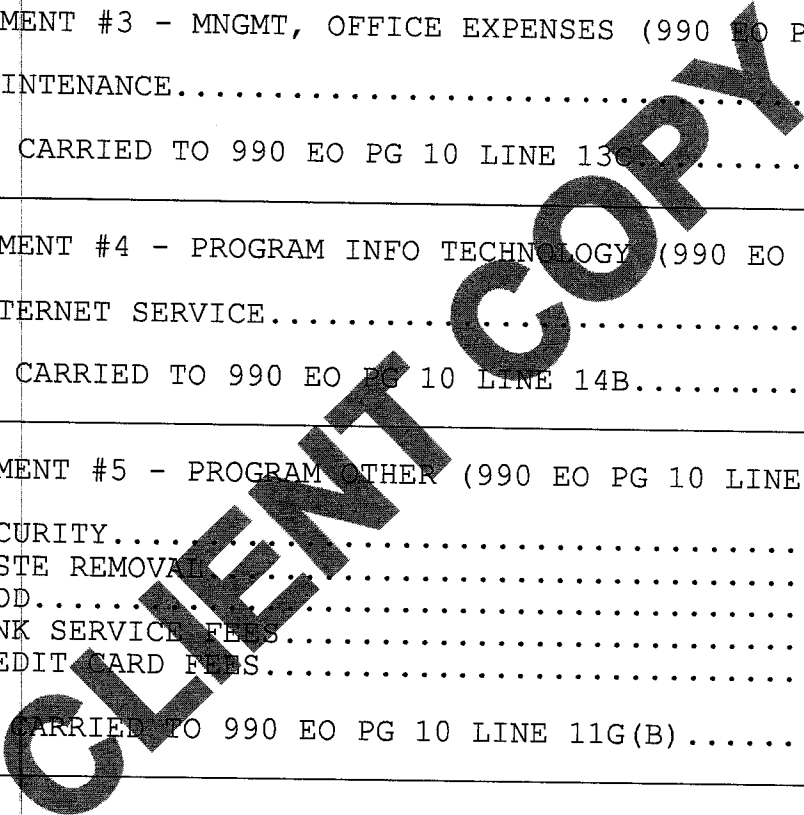

ARBITRATION IF A DISPUTE ARISES ("ARBITRATION AGREEMENT")

1. Scope of Arbitration Agreement. Right to Opt Out of This Arbitration Agreement: You may opt out of this Arbitration Agreement within the first 60 days after you sign this CSA by sending an email to arbitrationoptouts@hrblock.com, or by sending a signed letter to Arbitration Opt-Out, P.O. Box 32818, Kansas City, MO 64171. The email or letter should include your business or entity name, the name of your authorized representative submitting the opt out, the first five digits of your Federal Employer Identification Number, state and zip code of your principal place of business, and the words "Reject your principal place of business, and the words "Reject Arbitration." If you opt out of this Arbitration Agreement, any prior arbitration agreement shall remain in force and effect.

2. How Arbitration Works. Either party may initiate arbitration, which shall be conducted by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") pursuant to its Consumer Arbitration Rules or (if applicable) Commercial Arbitration Rules ("AAA Rules"), as modified by this Arbitration Agreement. The AAA Rules are available on the AAA's website www.adr.org, or by calling the AAA at (800) 778-7879. In the event the AAA is unavailable or unwilling to hear the dispute, the parties shall agree to, or the court shall select, another arbitration provider. Unless you and the H&R Block Parties agree otherwise, any arbitration hearing shall take place in the county of your principal place of business. 3. Waiver of Right to Bring Class Action and Representative Claims. All arbitrations shall proceed on an individual basis. The arbitrator is empowered to resolve the dispute with the same remedies available in court, including compensatory, statutory, and punitive damages; attorneys' fees; and declaratory, injunctive, and equitable relief. However, any relief must be individualized to you and shall not affect any other client.
